Entry level qualification for those seeking employment as an Assistant in Nursing, Support Worker, Carer or Personal Care Assistant.



Diploma of Nursing

In most States, successful completion of the Diploma of Nursing (or equivalent) may meet the academic requirements for registration as a Medication Endorsed Enrolled Nurse. (NB: different titles may apply in some States – i.e. Victoria - Division 2 Nurse)

Bachelor of Nursing

Tertiary qualification which satisfies the academic requirements for registration as a Registered Nurse.



Post-Graduate Qualifications

Post-Graduate qualifications include:

- Graduate Certificate
- Graduate Diploma
- Master of Nursing
- PhD in Nursing

Some universities offer Graduate Certificate courses in specific specialties which include: Intensive Care Nursing, Cancer Nursing, Emergency Nursing, Paediatric Nursing, Midwifery, Medical/Surgical Nursing, Perioperative and Mental Health.

Post graduate study in nursing may lead to employment opportunities as a Nurse Unit Manager, Nurse Educator, Clinical Nurse Consultant, Nurse Practitioner or Director of Nursing.

Nursing Specialties

Registered Nurses are able to work in a variety of specialty units within Private Hospitals such as:

Medical, Surgical, Operating Theatre, Emergency Department, Intensive Care, Cardiac, Obstetric, Paediatric, Rehabilitation and Mental Health.
